## **Fly on The Wall**

Below is an eye witness to the latest negotiations.

Talks lasted until 3 am Thursday.

For three days, Griswold and Bourne and the IBT Attorney tried to bring back the same as Continental, including medical and dental monthly co-pays of \$100-400.

An argument started between the Stewards and Clacy then Clacy went back to the company and in 5 minutes got rid of the monthly co-pays.

Editor's Note Clacy Griswold and the teamsters Attorney agreed to terminate United AMTs Medical Plan in the final 3-25-2011 TA

The IBT is trying to buy the vote at the base (SF0) by paying them for two licenses, instead of the current one.

There were 13 chief stewards, 5 were crowned as business agents and expected to vote to bring this tentative to the floor for a vote.

The remaining eight protested and said the new Business Agents were no longer eligible to vote because they are now paid by the Teamsters.

The last vote split 4 yes and 4 no, these were the remaining stewards. Two Chiefs said "This is Bullshit" and walked out.

For some upcoming Share holder meeting, the IBT wanted to say "We have a tentative."

Seems one of the Chief Stewards was going off on the IBT Attorney and ready to fight!

Almost had to call security!

Seems we are now in Limbo!  
No further meetings planned.  
Stay tuned.
